LOCKHEED MARTIN EMPLOYEE AWARDED FBI COMMUNITY LEADERSHIP HONOR



BALTIMORE, MD, May 10, 2007 – The Baltimore Division of the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) recently selected Lockheed Martin [NYSE: LMT] employee James Mullen for the “2006 FBI Director’s Community Leadership Award,” which recognizes individuals or organizations for contributions to crime prevention in their communities.

Mullen, a senior engineering design examiner at Lockheed Martin’s business in

Middle River, received the award for his continued help in overcoming poverty and crime within the Baltimore community. “I’m very excited that our efforts have been recognized by this award,” said Mullen. “The people in the community have seen us do what we’re doing, and this award is enabling us to do even more in the community.”

James Mullen is just one example of Lockheed Martin employees giving back to their local communities. In 2006, the 700 employees of Lockheed Martin’s Middle River business volunteered more than 9,500 hours of community service.
